## Hello Neighbor!



I wanted you to be aware that several days this coming week (M-F only) we will be putting a portable slalom course in the Western bay which consists of 22 buoys. This course will be removed each day. Feel free to have your skiers give it a try- it's a fun challenge!

There is no requirement for notice but as a courtesy we have notified Ed Kissinger, President of the Silver Lake Mgmt. District & The Sheriff's Department who patrol Silver Lake. The buoys will be placed in the Western bay adjacent to our common Lakeview Point & Southwest Camp Waushara shorelines. Please contact me directly with any questions or concerns.

**Please note:** You DO NOT HAVE TO CHANGE your use of the lake in any way. Drive through the course, fish through it, run PWC's through it, have fun! My only request would be to not intentionally run over a buoy even though they are designed to handle a direct hit. Enjoy the lake!

Those of us involved include several family members and many friends. Us adults are past our primes but we have rich histories in the sport. Some were professional show skiers, some were high level three-event skiers, some were sponsored competitive wakeboarders and others just like to have fun on the water with their families!

## TRIATHLON

The first God Bless America Triathlon was held at our cottage on Silver Lake amongst friends on July 4<sup>th</sup> 2006 after my then new brother-in-law challenged me to a race. It seemed like a cool idea to do it at Silvercryst the next year and Mike and James were up for it. Well, 300 people showed up and it was quite the event. A few years later, Wade Pennau from Wautoma Rental took over managing the event for several years. Since then, it has turned into a free event with a \$20 suggested donation. With absolutely zero promotion, it draws about 50-75 participants per year. Each year, we give what monies are left over after supply costs to a Veteran's organization. This year we donated \$438 to Wounded Warriors.

I see a future in which we promote the event again to elicit more participants and raise more money. Ideally, it would be something the entire lake community could be involved in supporting and participating. I know several families that consider it part of their July 4<sup>th</sup> tradition.
